Mount Olive Endowment Fund

Grants totaling \$5,025 were provided during the last year for support of mission work in Southeast Asia and Arizona and for tuition support for ministerial students at Concordia Seminary, St. Louis, MO and Concordia Theological Seminary, Fort Wayne, IN.

Grants come from interest earned from the base (corpus) of the Fund which currently is \$180,000. The corpus may not be used for grants, only the interest gained on the corpus. Money in the Fund is invested by a professional financial manager as directed by the Endowment Fund Committee. Because of the fluctuating market and grants issued over the past year there were no funds available recently for new grants. We pray for a better market taking place so funds will soon become available. Gifts amounting to \$1,900 were contributed to the Fund during the last fiscal year.

Grant Requests for 2016-2017

The Endowment Committee will be considering grant requests for 2016-2017 at their annual meeting on July 25, 2016. Requests for grants must be submitted by Monday, July 11, 2016.
